Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you that our long awaited building works will commence soon. Over the next two years we will see a transformation of the Bluecoat Aspley Academy. As I am sure you are aware, some of our buildings have been standing for over 50 years and it is time to bid them farewell.

In order for the works to go as smoothly as possible and to cause the least disruption, we will be moving our main reception to the entrance by our middle car park. Some of you may remember this as our old main reception! The move will commence from the 12th February, which is the last week of this half term. There will be no access to our current main entrance and this will be manned by employees from the construction company.

If you are visiting the Academy, please do access the site via the middle car park. I would like to reiterate that there will be a small amount of parents who will be allowed access to this car park both at the start and the end of the day, due to specific needs. Please do not come onto site at these times, unless it has been prearranged.

Please note: student reception will remain in the same place; however access to this will be from the pedestrian gate or the middle car park as well.

The first phase of the building works will be the construction of our new Science block, followed by Phase 2 with Science and Maths moving out of their buildings and a new building being constructed. Once this has been completed we will then move to the final phase where the English block will be removed.
