

Product Design – Designing your own clock.

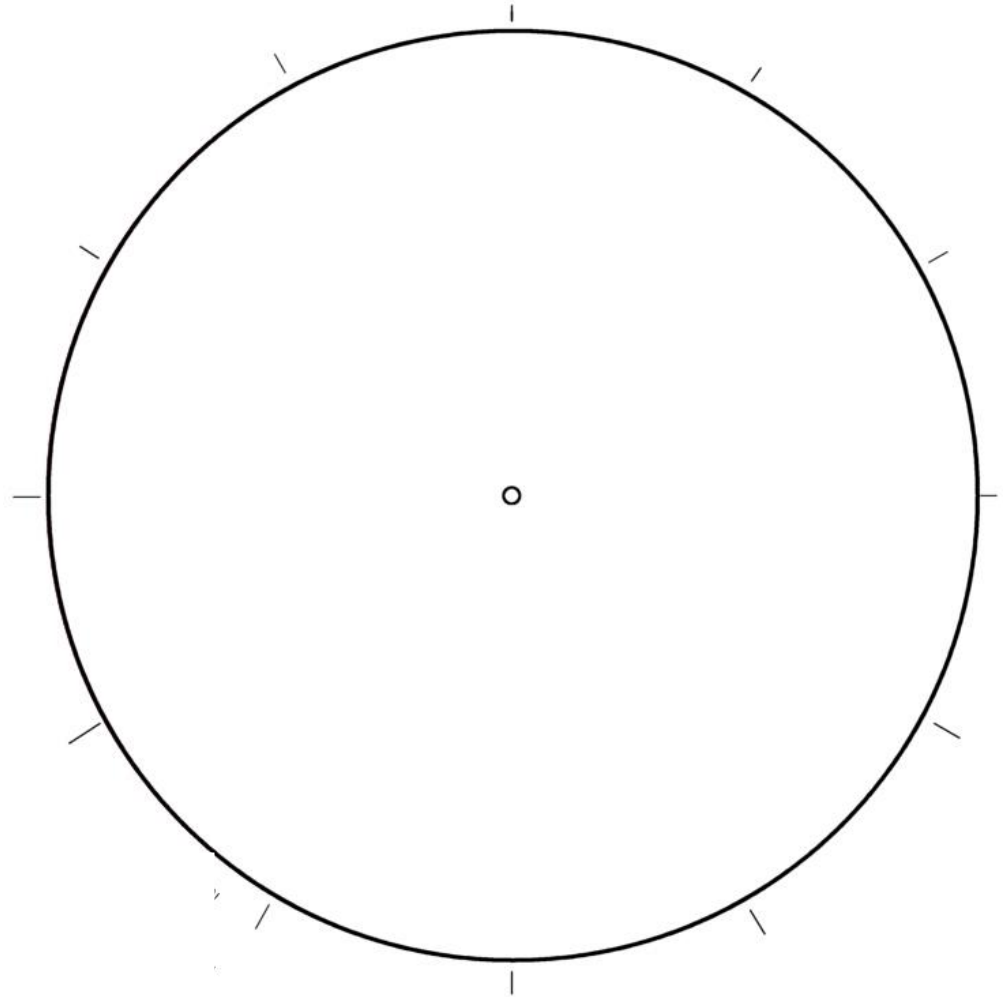

Task:

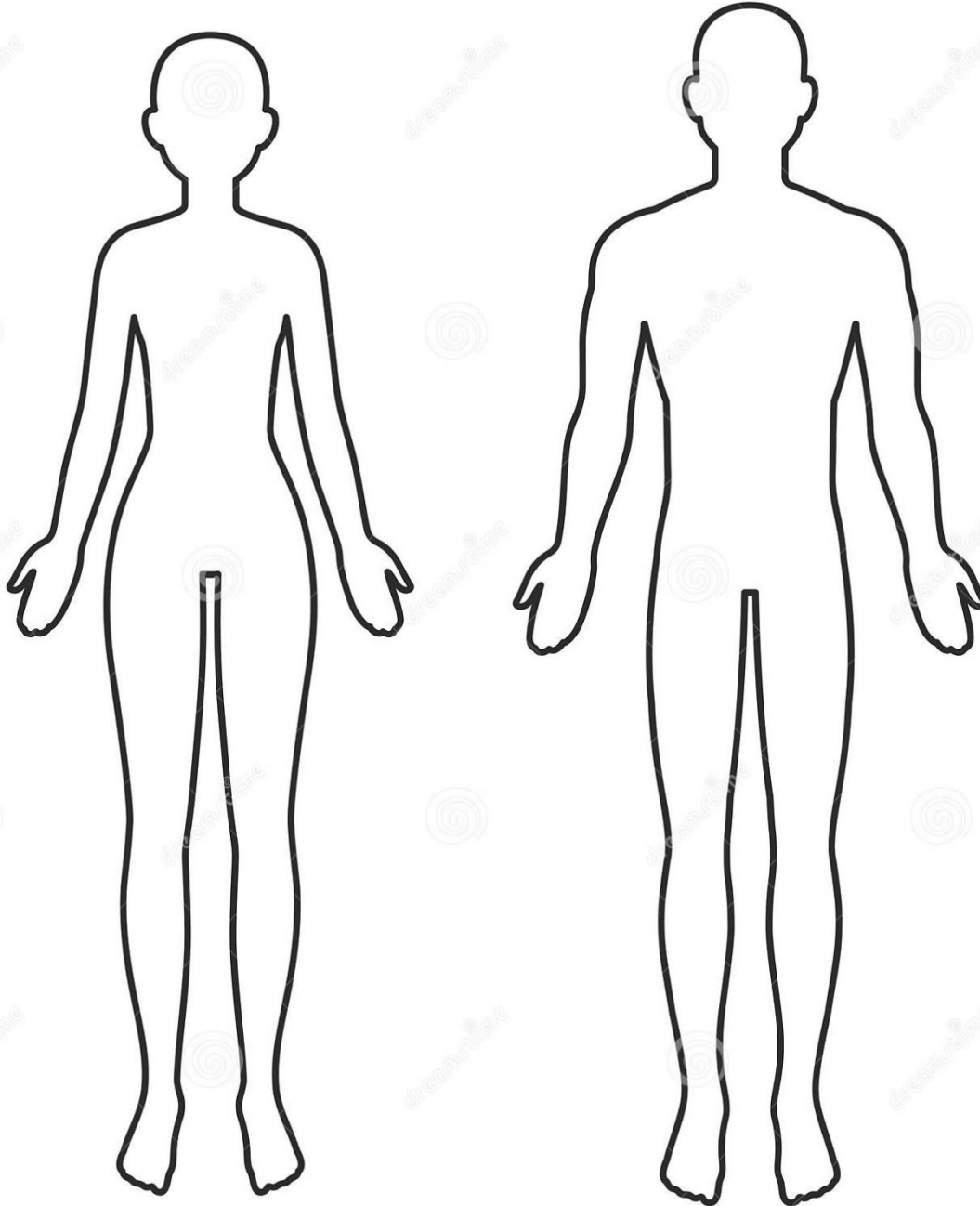
Produce a front to a clock which has a theme suitable for a child aged 10 or below.

Using the template on the left design an outfit suitable for a spy (such as James Bond). You can do either a male or female spy, the choice is yours!

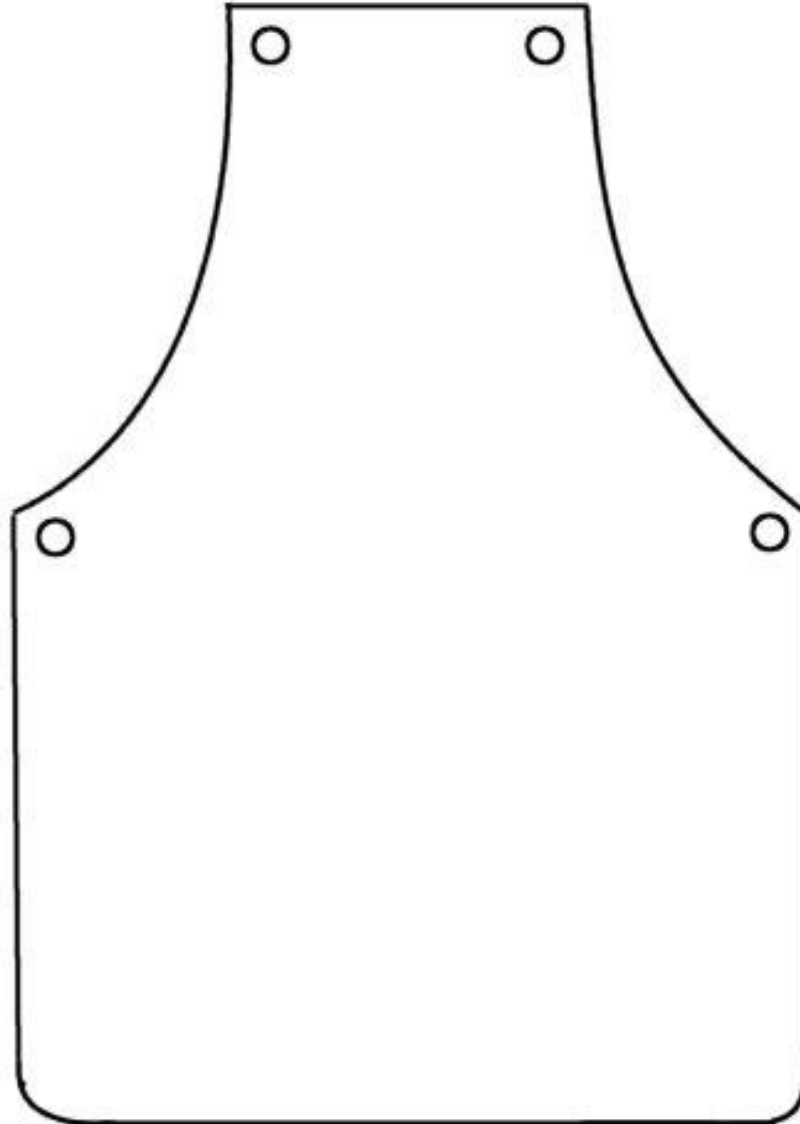
Remember to annotate (add notes) to your design idea and add colour to your design.
